






But does this great divorce really exist? Yes. We testify to it whenever we:

Lit: No (A) Millennium






# The Book of Revelation

**Dispensational View** 




#### THE STRUCTURE OF THE BOOK OF REVELATION

Chapters are shown in brackets





# **AMILLENNIALISM**



## Revelation 12:7-11

- (1) heavenly scene (v 7)
- (2) angelic battle against Satan and his hosts (vv 7-8)
- (4) the angel's evil opponent called "the great dragon, the ancient serpent, the one called the devil and Satan, the one deceiving the whole inhabited earth." (v 9)
- (5) Satan's expression of "great wrath because he knows he has little time" (v 12b)
- (6) Satan's fall, resulting in the kingdom of Christ (v10) and his saints (v 11; note the "conquering" theme)
- (7) the saints' kingship based not only on the fall of Satan and Christ's victory but also on the saints' faithfulness even to death in holding to "the word of their testimony" (v 11)

## Revelation 20:1-6

- (1) heavenly scene (v 1)
- (2) Presupposed angelic battle with Satan (v 2)
- (4) the angel's evil opponent called "the dragon, the ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan," restrained from "deceiving the nations any longer" (vv 2-3), to be loosed later to deceive the nations throughout the earth (vv 3, 7-8)
- (5) Satan to be "released for a short time" after his imprisonment (v3)
- (6) Satan's fall, resulting in the kingdom of Christ and his saints (v 4)
- (7) The saints' kingship, based not only on the fall of Satan but also on their faithfulness even to death in holding to "the word of God" (v 4)







Despite this, dispensationalists in positions of the US government deny the biblical eschatological significance of the earth except that the earth's environmental catastrophes are to be expected and even welcomed as sign of the coming rapture and therefore they are opposed to environmental care. Scherer, "Godly Must Be Crazy," No pages. "U.S. legislators backed by the Christian right vote against these issues [abortion, same-sex marriage, and stem-cell research] with near-perfect consistency. That probably doesn't surprise you, but this might: Those same legislators are equally united and unswerving in their opposition to environmental protection . . . Many Christian fundamentalists feel that concern for the future of our planet is irrelevant, because it has no future . . . They may also believe, along with millions of other Christian fundamentalists, that environmental destruction is not only to be disregarded but actually welcomed—even hastened—as a sign of the coming Apocalypse . . . We are not talking about a handful of fringe lawmakers who hold or are beholden to these beliefs . . . These politicians include some of the most powerful figures in the U.S. government, as well as key environmental decision makers . . . Because of its power as a voting bloc, the Christian right has the ear, if not the souls, of much of the nation's leadership. Some of those leaders are End-Time believers themselves. Others are not. Either way, their votes are heavily swayed by an electoral base that accepts the Bible as literal truth and eagerly awaits the looming Apocalypse. And that, in turn, is sobering news for those who hope for the protection of the earth, not its destruction . . . The social and environmental crises of our times, dispensationalists say, are portents of the Rapture, when born-again Christians, living and dead, will be taken up into heaven . . . Natural-resource depletion and overpopulation, then, are not concerns for End-Timers—and nor are other ecological catastrophes, which are viewed by dispensationalists as presaging the Great Tribulation . . . A plethora of End-Time preachers, tracts, films, and websites hawk environmental cataclysm as Good News—a harbinger of the imminent Second Coming."
